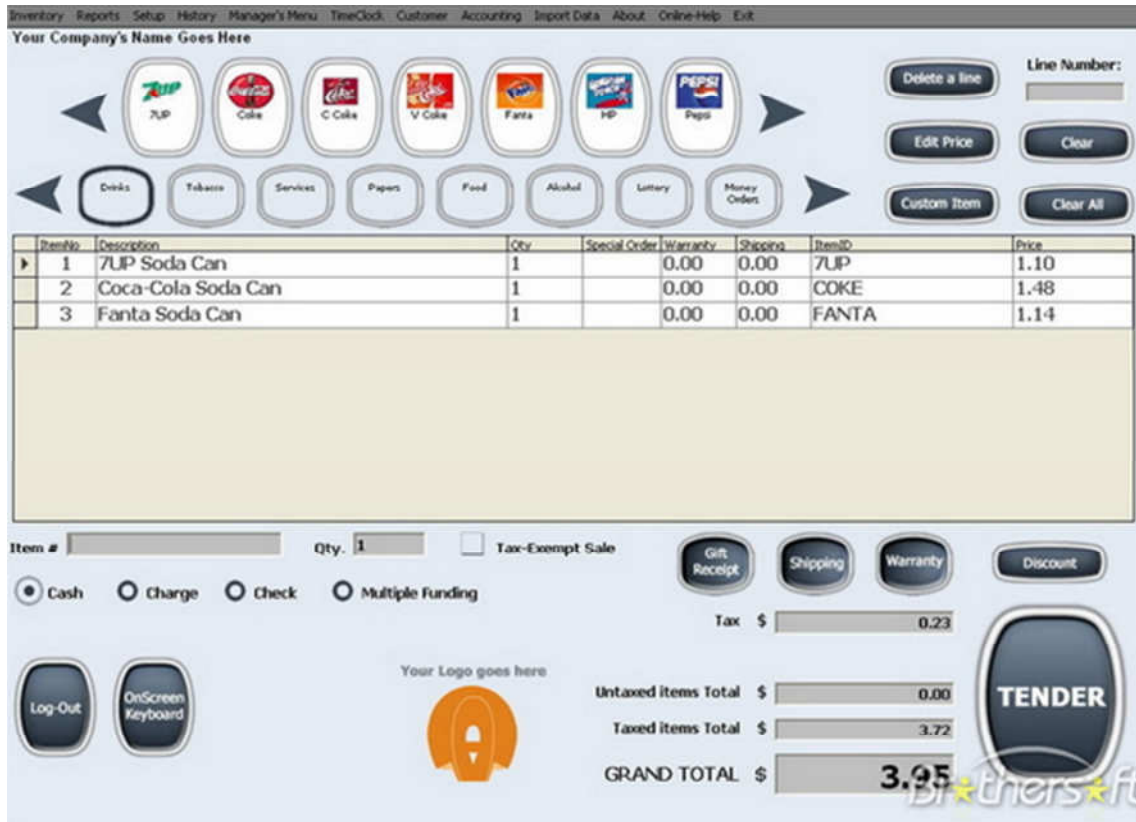


## Top 4 Best Free or Low Cost Inventory Management Software

### 1. POS Maid



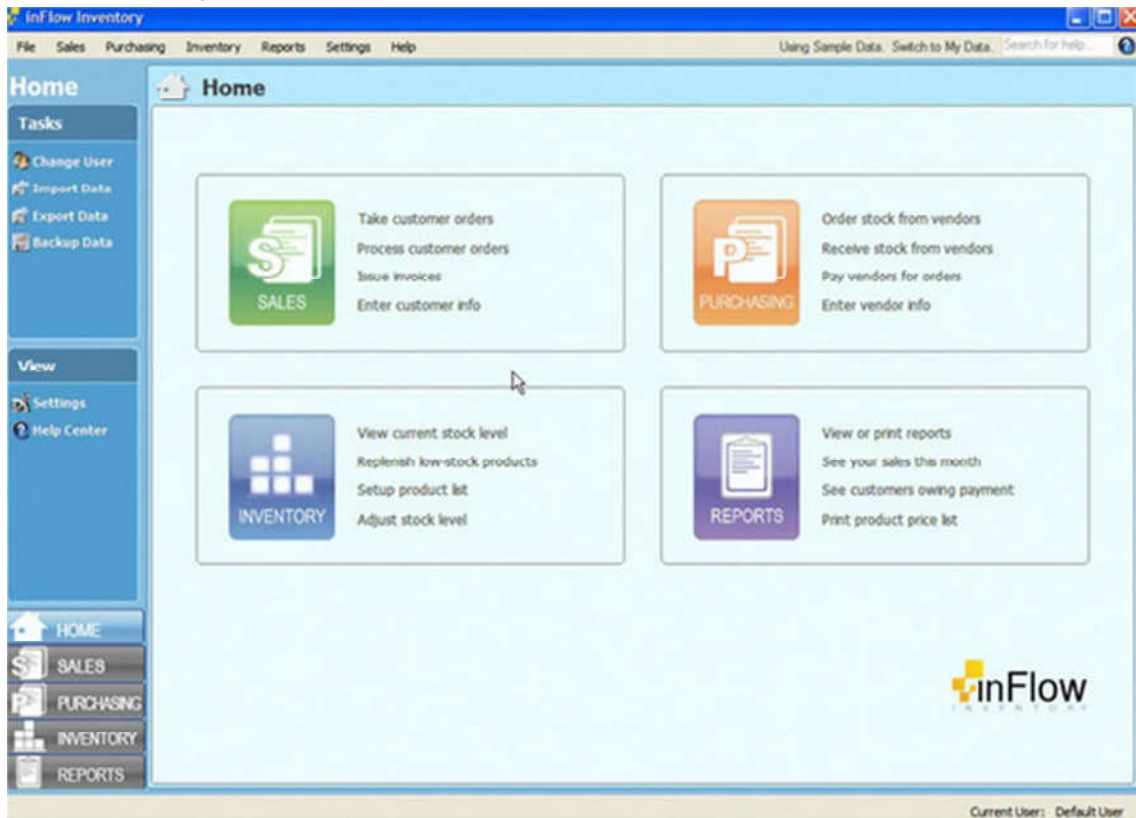
Pros: Building inventory within the system is easy and it's easy to operate

## 2. Inflow Inventory Free Version



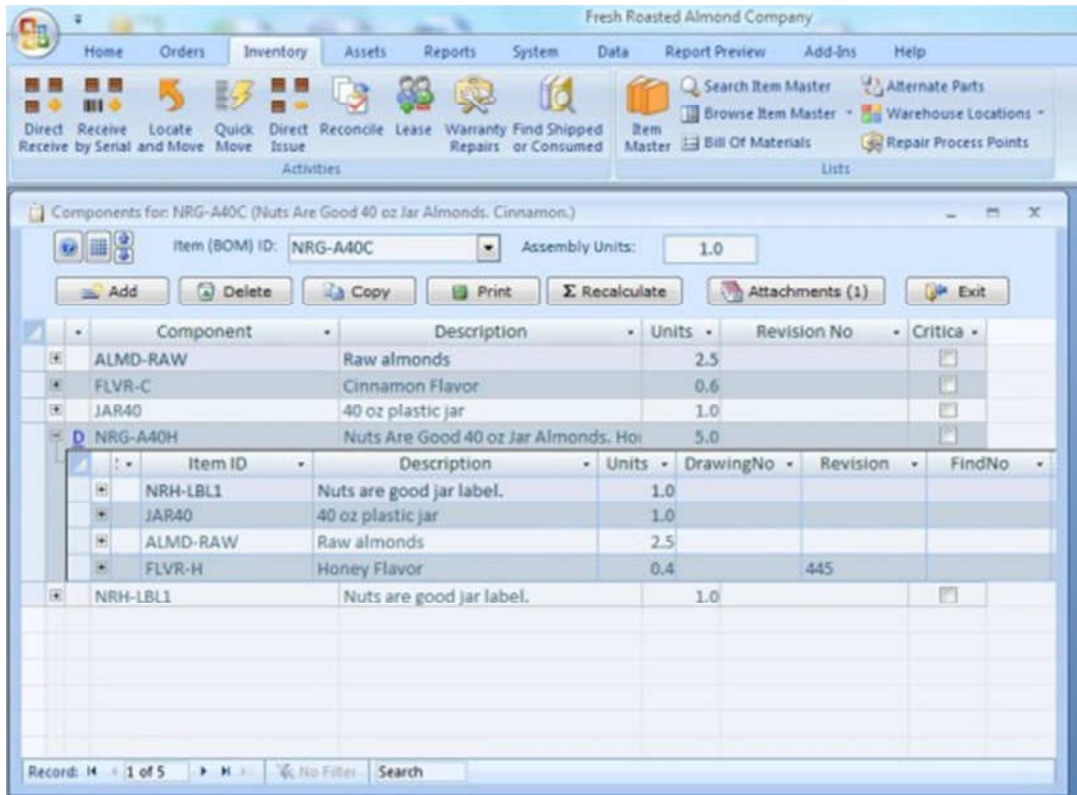
Pros: Easy and well-designed interface, customizable and full support. Professional look

### 3. ABC Inventory Software

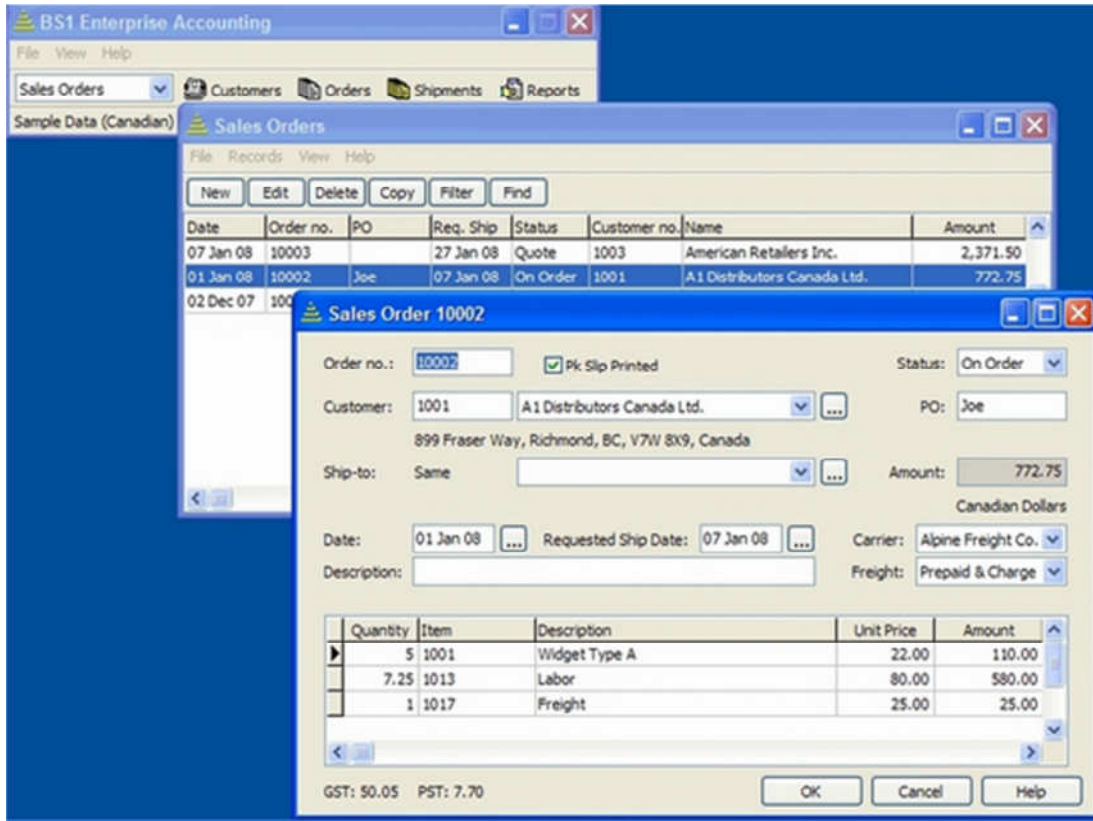


Pros: Reliable platform and product, good interface, scalable

#### 4. BS1 Enterprise Accounting Free Edition



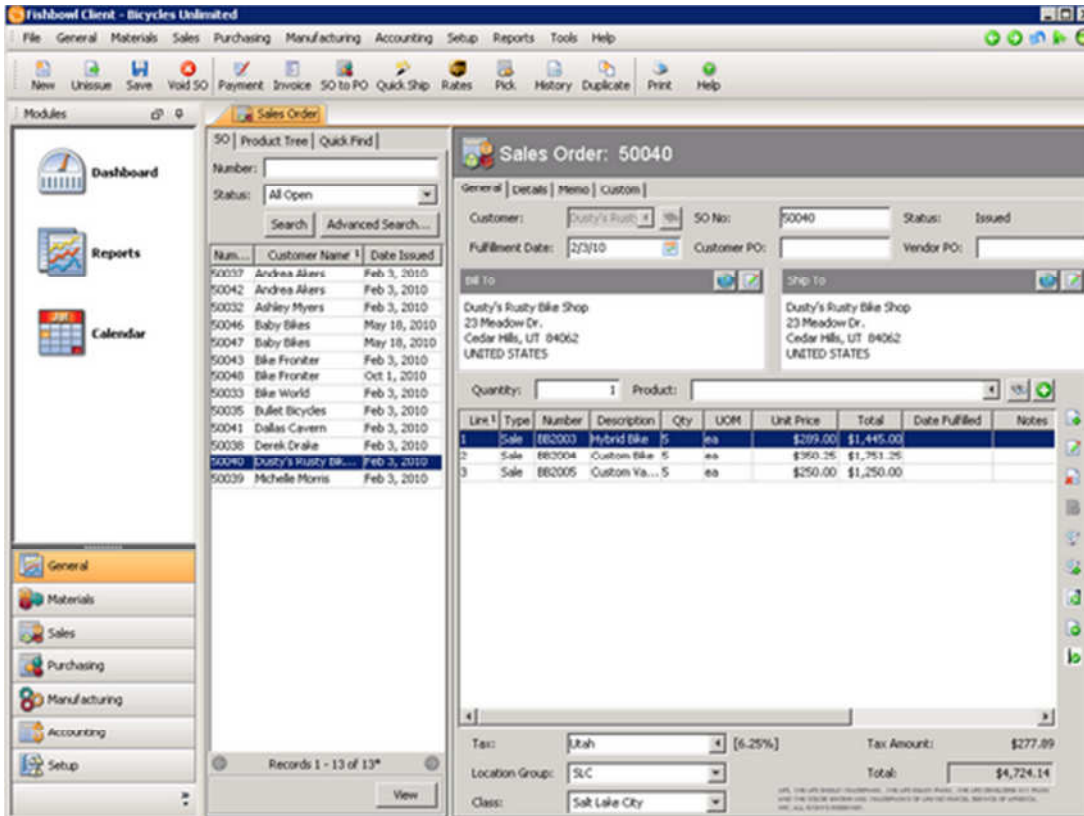
Pros: Intuitive and simple to use
